



The Cleburne Camera Club (CCC) is open to all area photographers, beginners as well as advanced. We meet on the first and third Mondays at 7 p.m.

Meetings are held at the Cleburne Senior Center, 1212 Glenwood Drive in Cleburne (behind the Conference Center).

We welcome all visitors and encourage you to become a member. Yearly dues are \$20 for individuals, \$35 for couples, and \$10 for students.

We encourage members to participate in club sponsored workshops, photo shoots and field trips.

You do not have to have an expensive camera to learn, so come join us!

Guest Speakers

We have a guest speaker at the first meeting of each month. Many are professional photographers with helpful information and tips to enable us to become better photographers.

Monthly Photo Critique

Each month we assign a different subject or theme which we photograph and turn in for a judge's critique. These monthly critiques encourage us to photograph places and subjects we might not think of on our own. We have categories for photo submissions. Class A is for Advanced and Class B is for Beginners.

You may enter three photos per month, one in each division - Color, Black & White or Monochrome, and Creative. In the Creative category, you're free to use your imagination, including drastic manipulations in image editing software.

At the second meeting of the month, photos are scored by outside judges and ribbons awarded. At year end the person with the most First Place ribbons is awarded "Photographer of the Year."

All these activities help you become a better photographer.
